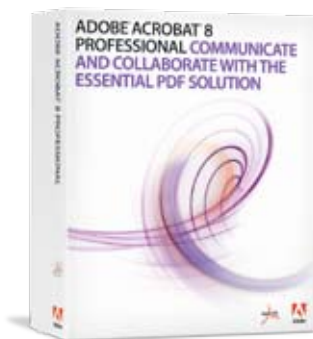

- Create Adobe PDF files easily by converting from Microsoft Word, Excel, and PowerPoint (as well as additional Microsoft applications on Windows) or scanning paper documents with robust OCR technology. Also, easily embed Adobe Flash® software animations (Windows only).
- Easily manage documents by assembling multiple related files into an Adobe PDF package. Maintain file integrity while allowing people to view, browse, sort, extract, and print select documents via a simple list window.
