- Update and swap animations.
- Relink Flash source file.
- Create and modify widgets in Flash for Captivate.

2. Performing Photoshop roundtripping

- Import Photoshop files.
- Edit Photoshop files from within Captivate.
- Update and relink Photoshop files.

3. Performing Audition roundtripping

- Edit audio with Audition for a single slide, objects, and background.
- Edit audio with Audition for a multiple slides and entire project.

4. Performing Adobe Device Central roundtripping

- Create a mobile project using Adobe Device Central.

- Test a mobile project using Adobe Device Central.
- 5. Performing Bridge integration**
- Create a new Captivate project using Bridge integration.
 - Add media to slides using Bridge integration.
- 6. Creating Quizzes using Learning Interactions**
- Use Quiz Templates in Flash.
 - Edit questions in the template.
 - Add and delete questions.
 - Create a SCORM package using learning interactions in Adobe Flash.
- 7. Using Multi-SCO Packager**
- Combine Adobe Captivate project output, Adobe Flash learning interactions, PDF files with or without interactive SWF files and quiz created using Adobe Flash, Adobe Presenter and CourseBuilder extension for Adobe Dreamweaver.
 - Create and publish trackable PDFs.
 - Publish and upload the packaged files.
- 8. Using CourseBuilder**
- Add CourseBuilder interaction.
 - Work with Action Manager.
 - Enable LMS tracking for CourseBuilder interactions.
 - Use eLearning templates in Dreamweaver to create courses.
- 9. Recording application in Adobe Flash**
- Record application in Adobe Flash.
 - Edit recording objects in Adobe Flash.
