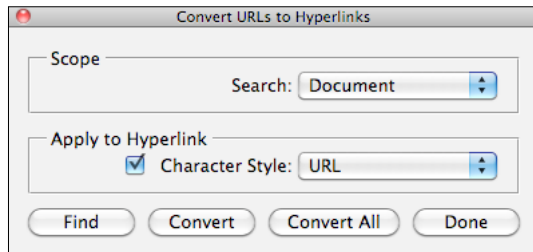

Volume 2: Interactive documents

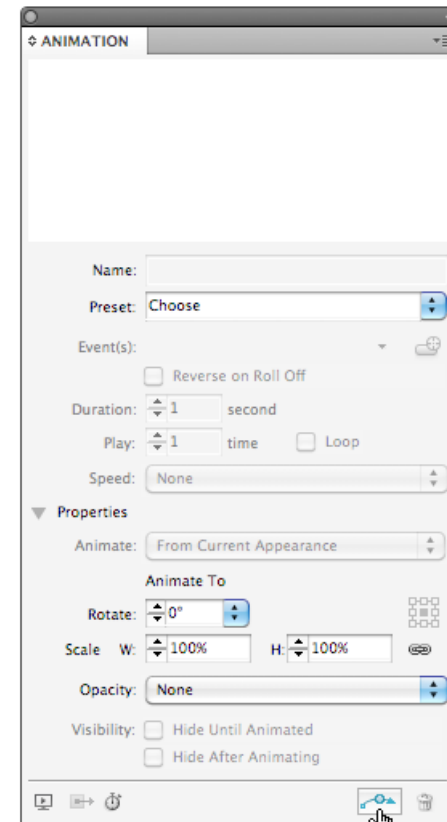
Creating interactive documents is easy in Adobe InDesign CS5 software, but it's even easier once you know about these three important features: Convert URL to Hyperlinks, the Preview panel, and Convert To Motion Path. You're only a few clicks away from creating interactive PDF and SWF files!



1 You can quickly convert all your document's web addresses to real, clickable hyperlinks by choosing Convert URL To Hyperlinks from the Hyperlinks panel menu. You can find the Hyperlinks panel in the Window > Interactive menu, along with other important panels.



2 The Preview panel (press Command+Shift+Return or Ctrl+Shift+Enter) shows how your SWF and PDF files will appear in Adobe Flash® Player and Adobe Acrobat®. Plus, buttons, hyperlinks, and animations actually work. Drag the corner of the panel to make it bigger.



3 You can turn any path—even one copied from Adobe Illustrator® software and pasted into InDesign—into a motion path. Select an object and a path, and then choose the Convert To Motion Path option in the Animation panel. If you selected two closed paths, such as two rectangles, the path on top becomes the motion path.
