



VERIFICATION OPINION DECLARATION GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS AND RENEWABLE ELECTRICITY

To: The Stakeholders of Adobe Inc.

Apex Companies, LLC (Apex) was engaged to conduct an independent verification of the greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions and renewable electricity reported by Adobe Inc. (Adobe) for the period stated below. This verification opinion declaration applies to the related information included within the scope of work described below.

The determination of the GHG emissions and renewable electricity is the sole responsibility of Adobe. Adobe is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of the GHG emissions and renewable electricity statement in accordance with the criteria. Apex's sole responsibility was to provide independent verification on the accuracy of the GHG emissions and renewable electricity reported and on the underlying systems and processes used to collect, analyze and review the information. Apex is responsible for expressing an opinion on the GHG emissions and renewable electricity statement based on the verification. Verification activities applied in a limited level of assurance verification are less extensive in nature, timing and extent than in a reasonable level of assurance verification.

Boundaries of the reporting company GHG emissions and renewable electricity covered by the verification:

- Operational Control
- Worldwide
- Excluded from Scope 3, Category 3 – Fuel and Energy Related Activities:
 - Upstream electricity generation GHG emissions for Adobe facilities located in the United States and United Kingdom
 - Well-to-tank GHG emissions from mobile fuels

Types of GHGs: CO₂, N₂O, CH₄, HFCs

GHG Emissions and Renewable Electricity Statement:

Data and information supporting the Scope 1 and Scope 2 GHG emissions statement and renewable electricity statement were mostly historical in nature.

Data and information supporting the Scope 3 GHG emissions statement were in some cases estimated rather than historical in nature.

Period covered by GHG emissions and renewable electricity verification:

- November 30, 2024 to November 28, 2025

Criteria against which verification was conducted:

- World Resources Institute (WRI)/World Business Council for Sustainable Development (WBCSD) Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Protocol Corporate Accounting and Reporting Standard (Scope 1 and 2)
- WRI/WBCSD Greenhouse Gas Protocol Corporate Value Chain Accounting and Reporting Standard (Scope 3)
- Internal Company Protocol (Percent Renewable Electricity)

Reference Standard:

- ISO 14064-3 Second Edition 2019-04: Greenhouse gases -- Part 3: Specification with guidance for the verification and validation of greenhouse gas statements
- Renewable electricity data was also verified using the principles and requirements of ISO 14064-3 as part of the verification process

Level of Assurance and Qualifications:

- Limited
- This verification used a materiality threshold of $\pm 5\%$ for aggregate errors in sampled data for each of the above indicators.



GHG Emissions and Renewable Electricity Verification Methodology:

Evidence-gathering procedures included but were not limited to:

- Interviews with relevant personnel of Adobe and their consultant;
- Review of documentary evidence produced by Adobe and their consultant;
- Review of Adobe data and information systems and methodology for collection, aggregation, analysis and review of information used to determine GHG emissions and renewable electricity; and
- Audit of sample of data used by Adobe to determine GHG emissions and renewable electricity.

Verification Opinion:

Based on the process and procedures conducted, there is no evidence that the GHG emissions and renewable electricity statement shown above:

- is not materially correct and is not a fair representation of the GHG emissions and renewable electricity data and information; and
- has not been prepared in accordance with the WRI/WBCSD GHG Protocol Corporate Accounting and Reporting Standard (Scope 1 and 2), and WRI/WBCSD Greenhouse Gas Protocol Corporate Value Chain Accounting and Reporting Standard (Scope 3).

It is our opinion that Adobe has established appropriate systems for the collection, aggregation and analysis of quantitative data for determination of these GHG emissions and renewable electricity for the stated period and boundaries.
