



## PSLT – Firefly Custom Model (2026v1)

This PSLT governs Customer’s access and use of the Firefly Custom Model add-on to Customer’s Creative Cloud entitlement and is incorporated by reference into Customer’s license to Creative Cloud. Customer’s use of, and license to, outputs from Firefly Custom Models, is governed by the Customer’s separate Creative Cloud license, described below in section 2.3 (Separate License for Outputs).

### 1. DEFINITIONS

- 1.1. **“Customer Training Data”** means the content that is provided to Adobe by or on behalf of Customer for the purpose of training, fine tuning, or otherwise customizing any Firefly generative AI models for Customer.
- 1.2. **“Firefly Custom Model”** or **“Custom Model”** is a model that can be created or generated through a Training Run.
- 1.3. **“Trained Custom Model”** is a Custom Model that has completed a Training Run and has not been deleted by Customer.
- 1.4. **“Training Run”** means use of the On-demand Services to initiate a request to create a customized model based on Customer Training Data.

### 2. GENERAL TERMS

- 2.1. **Access.** This product is an On-demand Service that, as of the License Term Start Date, is made available through the “Custom Models” module of the Firefly website, located at [firefly.adobe.com](https://firefly.adobe.com) (or successor URL) (**“Firefly Website”**). This product may also be made available in other applications or websites as described in Documentation.
- 2.2. **Custom Model License.** With this product, Adobe grants Customer access to On-demand Services to initiate Training Runs to create Custom Models. Customer may store up to the Quantity of Trained Custom Models, as set forth in the Products and Services Pricing Detail table, in the On-demand Services.
- 2.3. **Separate License for Outputs.** To generate outputs with Custom Models, Users must be assigned a separate Adobe Creative Cloud license, subject to separate terms, that include access to Products and Services that can generate with Custom Models, such as the Firefly Website. The Custom Model license, by itself, does not include output generation.
- 2.4. **Output Indemnification.** Any indemnity that would apply to outputs of Custom Models would come from the separate Creative Cloud license. If the separate Creative Cloud license includes Firefly Output indemnification, then Customer Training Data shall be considered as Firefly Input for the purposes of that Firefly Output indemnification as defined in the applicable Creative Cloud license. There is no additional and separate Firefly Output indemnification for Custom Model. “Firefly Output” and “Firefly Input” are defined in the section for that indemnification, if Customer is provided that indemnification.
- 2.5. **Internal Use Only.** Customer’s use of Custom Models is for internal use only. Customer must not permit its clients to access or use Custom Models; however this does not restrict Customer from sharing with clients the outputs generated with Custom Models.

### 3. CUSTOMER ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

- 3.1. Customer must have Enterprise Storage for Business enabled (learn more [here](#)).
- 3.2. Custom Models are designed to only be compatible with specific Firefly generative AI models. In the event that these Firefly generative AI models become unsupported, Customer is required to retrain the impacted Custom Models in order to continue generating outputs, via the separate Creative Cloud license, from those Custom Models.
- 3.3. Adobe cannot provide Customer with a copy of any Custom Model because Custom Models are provided as a hosted service and are designed only to operate in conjunction with Adobe's Firefly foundational models and technology and cannot be separated or copied for Customer.

### 4. BETA FEATURES

- 4.1. Adobe may provide access to On-demand Services or a feature of the On-demand Services, as a no-cost prerelease, early access, or beta version (“**Beta Version**”). A Beta Version does not represent the final product and may contain bugs. Adobe may choose not to release a commercial version of the Beta Version.
- 4.2. Adobe provides the Beta Version on an “AS-IS” basis. Adobe may develop, modify, improve, support, customize, and operate its products and services based on Customer’s use, as applicable, of any Beta Versions.
