All competition winners will receive a 12-month Adobe Creative Cloud membership subscription as well as a chance to participate in ADAA community events, workshops, and boot camps. Each individual winner and the designated leader of each group winner will receive an invitation to attend '2016 Adobe MAX,' the global creative conference which is to be held in San Diego, United States, in November. Each individual winner and the designated leader of each group winner will also be provided a year-long mentorship from an industry leader for a chance to enhance one's creative ability and portfolio.
