



PSLT India Addendum - Adobe Sign (2020v1)

1. **Applicability.** This PSLT India Addendum applies if Customer uses the Aadhaar e-sign Services. These terms apply in addition to the PSLT - Adobe Sign. Capitalised terms not defined here will have the meaning given to them in the General Terms or the PSLT – Adobe Sign (as relevant).
2. **e-sign Electronic Signature Services.**
 - 2.1 Adobe, through one of its Affiliates in India (“**Adobe India**”), is providing the Customer and Customer’s End Users the option to authenticate their electronic signatures using Aadhaar e-KYC services (“**Aadhaar e-sign Services**”). If Customer chooses to use the Aadhaar e-sign Services, the terms and conditions governing the use of the Aadhaar e-sign Services available here: https://www.adobe.com/content/dam/cc/en/legal/terms/enterprise/pdfs/Services-Terms-Adobe-Sign-Aadhaar_Enterprise-en_IN_20200902.pdf (“**Aadhaar e-sign Services Terms**”), will automatically apply without any further actions on the part of any party. The Aadhaar e-sign Services Terms will comprise a separate agreement between Adobe India and the Customer. The Customer is responsible for any data that Customer or its End User’s enter into, supply or use in conjunction with the Aadhaar e-sign Services. In the event of any conflict between the terms of the Agreement and the terms of the Aadhaar e-sign Services Terms, the terms of the Aadhaar e-sign Services Terms will prevail as they relate to Customer’s use of the Aadhaar e-sign Services.
 - 2.2 It is Customer’s responsibility to determine what notices, consents, and controls are required in order to comply with laws, standards, regulations, or obligations that Customer may have to Customer’s End Users, including those under the (Indian) Information Technology Act, 2000, the Personal Data Protection Bill, 2019 (once enacted), Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 and Aadhaar (Authentication) Regulations, 2016, and all applicable guidelines, directives, policies and manuals issued by the Unique Identification Authority of India and the Controller of Certifying Authorities in relation to the Aadhaar e-sign Services.
 - 2.3 The information provided to the Customer by Adobe and Adobe India under the Agreement and the Aadhaar e-sign Services Terms, will be held in the strictest confidence by the Customer, and the Customer must not, in any manner, divulge, discuss, disclose or directly or indirectly use such information, other than for purposes set out under the Agreement and the Aadhaar e-sign Services Terms.
