Adobe Adds Refine Edge Brush and Rotate Canvas Capability to Photoshop on iPad

Hong Kong — July 28, 2020 — Adobe (Nasdaq: ADBE) has released new features to Photoshop on iPad including the Refine Edge Brush which allows Photoshop to deliver incredibly precise image selection capabilities and control on the iPad for the trickiest subjects like hair and fur, and precise pixel selection which is fundamental to achieving realistic results and is made to sing with pencil and touch. In addition, Adobe continues to focus on the unique ergonomics of adding a touch interface to Photoshop, and has also released the ability to rotate the canvas while editing.

The Refine Edge Brush pushes Photoshop's selections results well beyond anything else available on the iPad today. Now users can precisely refine the border area of tricky selections and brush over soft areas such as hair or fur to add fine details and achieve realistic, professional quality selections of objects with a mix of sharp and soft edges — just with a few brush strokes. Examples include lots of flyaway hair or removing subjects from complex backgrounds. While the interface has been tuned a little for the iPad, it works just like Photoshop on the desktop and produces the same results.




Image 1: Lots of flyaway hair




Image 2: Precise pixel selection for the trickiest subjects like hair and fur to achieve realistic results




Image 3: Users can precisely refine the border area of tricky selections and brush over soft areas such as hair or fur.

Refine Edge is a key leap forward for creativity. Now, Photoshop offers the most comprehensive, high quality image selection tools available on the iPad. And like all the other major innovations added to Photoshop, Adobe doesn't stop when it ships the first version of the feature - the team has already checked in more performance and other improvements to Refine Edge that will roll out with the next release.

Rotate Canvas

Adobe continues to add the highly anticipated capabilities that make working on the iPad far more natural and fluid. Now users can rotate the canvas with a two-finger gesture and snap at 0, 90, 180, 270 degrees. Both rotation and snapping can be toggled on/off in the Settings /Touch menu.




Image 4: The rotation can snap at 0, 90, 180, 270 degrees.
