Adobe Fresco, previously known as Project Gemini, provides artists with multiple digital brush tools for their creative process. In addition to sharp, clean, infinitely scalable vector brushes and versatile and adaptable Photoshop brushes, Fresco also includes new Live Brushes that recreate the experience of painting with oils or watercolors.

The app enables users to experiment with different kinds of media and techniques on an iPad. It provides professional and amateur creators a flexible and forgiving environment to try materials that most novices would never have access to, leading more people to discover the joys of painting and drawing.

Adobe Creative Cloud subscribers can now download Adobe Fresco. Non-subscribers can try the full version of the app for free for the first six months or purchase as a standalone app.
