

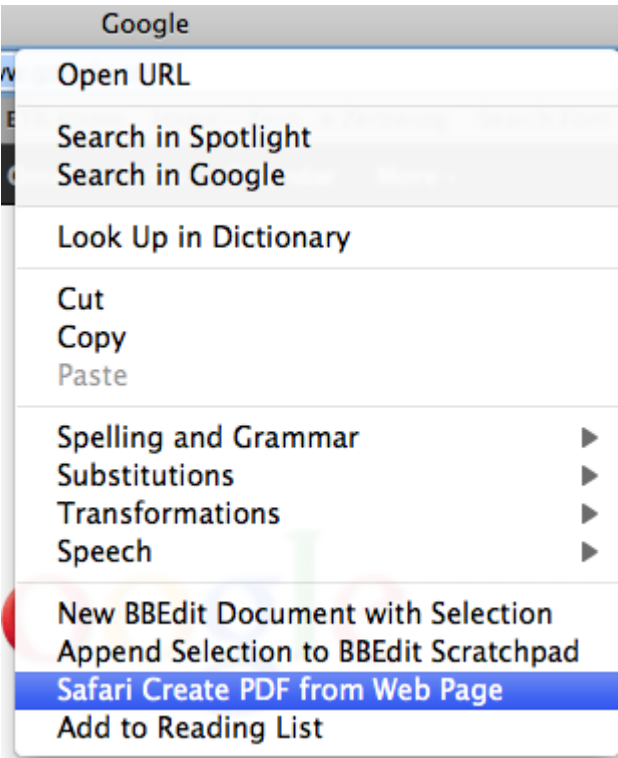
Create PDF Utility for Safari

Overview

When Acrobat is installed on a Macintosh, the Create PDF feature is not automatically enabled in Safari. This utility adds a menu item to Safari’s context menu so that you can create a PDF from any Web page.



Installation

After downloading the zip file and extracting it to any location, do one of the following:

Method 1

1. Double click on **document.workflow** file.
2. When prompted, choose **Install**.
3. Copy the file **WebCapture.pdf** to the root of the Macintosh hard drive.

Method 2

1. Copy the file **document.workflow** to /Users/[USERNAME]/Library/Services/.
2. Copy the file **WebCapture.pdf** to the root of the Macintosh hard drive.

Usage

Simply choose **Safari Create from Web Page** when viewing a web page in Safari.

To uninstall the tool, just delete the files from the machine.

What are the known issues and bugs?

Running the Acrobat JavaScript method "app.getURL();" necessitates opening a PDF document momentarily before running it. The AppleScript/Acrobat JavaScript AIC scripting combination opens a file named WebCapture.pdf" (attached) located at the root of the drive. You can modify the script as needed.
