

# Adobe® Pixel Bender® Toolkit 2.1 Installer Fix ReadMe

---

## Overview

In certain install scenarios, the Pixel Bender Toolkit 2.1 installer introduced an issue which prevents users from successfully un-installing Pixel Bender Toolkit 2.1 or updating to newer versions of Pixel Bender Toolkit 2, such as Pixel Bender Toolkit 2.5. To resolve the problem, if a user installed Pixel Bender Toolkit 2.0 and then downloaded and installed Pixel Bender Toolkit 2.1 from the [Pixel Bender Technology Center](http://www.adobe.com/devnet/pixelbender/), you must download and run the “AdobeCS5\_HotFixV1” script.

## Getting Started

1. Download and un-package the “Pixel Bender Toolkit 2.1 Installer HotFix” onto a directory/folder on your hard drive from the Pixel Bender Technology Center:  
<http://www.adobe.com/devnet/pixelbender/>.
2. Run the installed “AdobeCS5\_HotFixV1” script:
  - **In Windows:**
    - Select Start > All Programs > Accessories > Command Prompt.
    - On **Windows Vista and Windows 7**: right-click on the Command Prompt application and select the “Run as administrator” item.
    - On **Windows XP**: right-click on the Command Prompt application, select the “Run as...” item, and log in as a user with Administrator rights.
    - Run AdobeCS5\_HotFixV1.exe.
  - **In Mac OS**: Open Applications\Utilities\Terminal and use the sudo command to run the AdobeCS5\_HotFixV1 script.
3. If it was successful, the script will output "Success" to the Windows Command Prompt or the Macintosh Terminal.  
If it failed, the script will output "Fail".
4. Proceed either with un-installation of Pixel Bender Toolkit 2.1 or installation of Pixel Bender Toolkit 2.5 from the [Pixel Bender Technology Center](http://www.adobe.com/devnet/pixelbender/).
